Try to get a shot that looks like it's out of a picture-book world.

#### Pointers for Getting Your Best Shot

Subject matter like autumn leaves and cherry blossoms can disappear overnight. The best is if you can shoot them at just the right time, of course, but that can be pretty tough. Even if your timing isn't optimal, though, you can adjust the density in your shots by pulling a little farther back or stepping a little closer in. Try shooting from a wide range of different angles.
